

## 2-D ART OVERVIEW

### Description

This course will build upon the concepts learned in Art Foundations 1, with continued emphasis placed on drawing and observational skills. Students will identify how the elements and principles of design are used in the world around us and how to implement them into their own works of art. Drawing, painting and printmaking will be explored using a variety of media.

### Learning Expectations

- Identify themes in the world around us.
- Use themes in original works of art.
- Demonstrate the use of a variety of different art media and techniques.
- Experience observational skills and drawing for accuracy.
- Enlarge a drawing using a grid.
- Enlarge a drawing without the use of a grid.
- Show movement and direction using gesture lines.
- Perform a series of contour line drawings emphasizing different concepts and techniques.
- Demonstrate variance in line quality using a variety of media.
- Use the correct proportions to draw the human face.
- Create a composition showing asymmetrical balance and interest.
- Use repetition of shapes to form patterns.
- Mix colors and values using a variety of media.
- Identify and use color schemes in original works of art.
- Demonstrate watercolor washes using multiple colors.
- Show mastery of painting techniques emphasizing neatness and defined edges.
- Define edges through the use of shading rather than line.
- Complete a value study.
- Draw an original design demonstrating the balance of positive and negative space.
- Show depth and creativity using 1 and 2 point perspective techniques.
- Create depth on a 2-D surface using overlapping, placement, and size.
- Experience different methods of printmaking and/or scratch art.
- Identify the elements and principles of design in art compositions.
- Identify, discuss and write about techniques and elements used in works of art.
- Demonstrate the steps to self-critique and make improvements to personal work.
- Demonstrate safe and proper use of materials and equipment.
- Show effective cleanup procedures.
